Guests will be given a free postcard-sized map of the venues and are welcome to drive between stadiums.

Guided Ski Jump Tours

Ride the lift to the top of the ski jumps enjoy the spectacular view, learn about the facility, ski jumping and Nordic combined sports and then hike down or take the lift back to the landing area.

Tours run weekends only starting Saturday June 6, 2009 until August 30, 2009 from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm Tours depart every hour on the hour.
